

PRECAUTIONS FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICES

(starting 3/6/22)

- Self-screening: Please participate online and not in person
 - o if you display COVID symptoms (e.g. fever, shortness of breath, cough),
 - or if you have been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed with COVID or is awaiting a COVID test result,
 - or if you yourself are awaiting a COVID test result.
- Masking and social distancing are optional: There will be designated spaces in the sanctuary for those who wish to sit socially distant from other households, and/or sit with others who are wearing masks.
- Projection, slides, and bulletins:
 - We will have everything projected on a screen (e.g. song lyrics, liturgy, sermon slides).
 - But if the screen is difficult to see, you may also access and download the projection slides onto your mobile device from this <u>googlefolder</u>.
 - We will also have paper bulletins available for those who would like one.
- **Offering:** We have resumed collecting an offering as part of our worship. An offering box will also be placed by the Welcome Table for those who would like to give that way. You may also give <u>online</u> or by mail.
- **Pre-packaged communion:** We will provide pre-packaged communion elements for communing participants (wine or juice; regular bread or gluten-free bread).

- In our children and youth classrooms,

- o masks are recommended for age 2 and up, but not required
- o the children/youth will be allowed to share supplies and toys again
- we will relax our 3 feet social distancing policy
